Thank you so much to those of you who completed our camper and/or parent surveys. (If you haven't had a chance yet, that's okay -- there's still time to do so!) One of the most important things we do in the fall is to think about how we can be even better in the future. We firmly believe that although Akeela is amazing and wonderful, it can always be improved.

We, along with our head counselors, spend a great deal of time writing individual camper reports at the end of each camp session. We believe it's worth the time and energy because many parents have expressed how helpful it is to have a written document to share with other professionals in their children's lives.
